1968 First Shipman, a 28 footer, is built on the island of Visby in Sweden.

1981 Shipman is sold to Denmark. In the years 1968 to 1986 thousands of Shipmans are built in Sweden and Ireland, making Shipman one of the best known sailing brands in Scandinavia and Northern Europe.

1992 Shipman 8 m One Design was born, designed by J&J design and built by Seaway.

2002 Shipman was acquired by Seaway and the development of the first carbon-built Shipman 50 is started.

2004 Shipman 50 wins the European boat of the year title over all categories.

2005 Shipman 63 sets sail, wins European boat of the year title in 2006.

2007 Shipman 72 and 80 launched before end of the year.

2010 Start of the Shipman 100 project.

Uniqueness

- Shipman is a single-handed pilothouse high-performance carbon yacht in size of 50 up to 150 feet.
- Currently in production Shipman 63, 72 and 80.
- It is the only semi custom carbon boat of this kind on market and Shipman is the leading producer of carbon boats worldwide.

Production

- Production in the new shipyard in Monfalcone/Tržič started in September 2009.
- Production of Shipman and Skagen yachts moved from Slovenia to Italy.
- Reasons for choosing Monfalcone.
